	Painting Board – larger than paper size (gatorboard or plexiglass - good choices)
	Tracing paper – size to cover watercolor paper
	Graphite paper – (or portable light table if you have one)
	Drawing pencil
	Kneaded eraser
	Clear packaging tape
	Containers for water
	Painting Palette
	Paper Towels & Kleenex
	Hair dryer if you have one
	Brushes - 2" flat, round # 2 – #4 - #8 (instructor prefers synthetic)
	Masking fluid and application tool. (Chisel ended brush works well)
	Small piece of coarse sandpaper – (3" square is sufficient)
	Watercolor pencils (preferably woodless)— colors should be similar to paint colors below
	Paints: Daniel Smith Watercolor Essentials set OR individual equivalent colors:  ☐ Antwerp Blue − OR Phthalo Blue ☐ Ultramarine Blue ☐ Windsor Yellow − OR Cadmium Yellow ☐ Windsor Red − OR Cadmium Red medium ☐ Alizarin Crimson
	<ul> <li>OTHER NEEDED COLORS:</li> <li>□ Burnt Sienna</li> <li>□ Quinacridone gold (preferred) – (alternately -natural sienna or yellow ochre)</li> <li>□ Opaque white</li> <li>□ Optional – Turner brand: Freshwater. Daniel Smith brand: Sedona Genuine, Sleeping Beauty Turquoise Genuine, Amethyst Genuine. These give an extra sparkle and texture if you like.</li> </ul>
