## Materials List

- GLUE
  - “Yes Paste” glue
- PAPER / COLLAGE
  - “Cold Press” watercolor paper, 9” x 12” pad, either Arches or Strathmore
  - Mixed media materials (Printed images, papers, fabrics, photos, found items, colored papers)
  - Black and white photos for reference material / subject matter
  - Drawing paper (medium thickness to paint on and cut up)
  - Colored pencils, crayons, oil pastels (choose which you like)
- BRUSHES
  - ONE Pentel Aquash water brush pen (large) size, *you could also use regular watercolor brushes if you have some.*
  - (optional) ~1 inch wide disposable paint brush from Lowe’s
- WATERCOLOR
  - Watercolor palette with ~ 15 wells for colors and mixing space
  - small jar to rinse watercolor brush in
  - COLORS: I highly recommend that you purchase good quality pigments, from professional artist brands such as: **M. Graham, Daniel Smith, or Winsor Newton Artist Watercolors.** Good pigments are lightfast. *If you already have a watercolor starter set, go ahead and use what you have.*
  - *If you don’t know much about watercolor, buy a good quality starter pack.*
  - **SUGGESTED LIST OF COLORS 5ml tubes or half pans**
    - **With these first 4 colors, you can mix just the rainbow...**
      - Phthalo blue (green shade)
      - Hansa yellow light
      - quinacridone pink or quinacridone magenta
      - Permanent white gouache
    - **These colors give you more natural options...**
      - pyroll red or winsor red
      - violet dioxazine
      - winsor yellow
      - quinacridone gold
      - burnt sienna
      - buff titanium
      - neutral tint

- Indanthrone blue
- hookers green
- MISC
  - A roll of paper towels or an old tshirt rag
  - Large and small scissors
  - pencil and eraser
  - Ruler
  - Masking tape
  - Drawing board to work on (optional)

### **Where to purchase supplies?**

I recommend you purchase supplies online at Jerry's Artarama or Dick Blick, or locally Artisan Santa Fe in Nob Hill can help you. Michael's and Hobby will probably have some options too. There are usually coupons and sales when you purchase at the online stores with free shipping.
