Wear comfortable, neutral colored, layered clothing, especially shoes.
Bring a cap or hat, insect repellant, drinking water, sunscreen and a folding chair. For artwork, pleas bring the following:

French Easle with mixing palette
Sketchbook with charcoal pencil
Odorless paint solvent (Gamsol)
Brush cleaning can
Lidded cup of painting medium
Paper towels
Brushes: preferably "interlocked hog bristle \#3, \#4, \#6, \#8, \#10, some synthetic brushes
may be helpful
Palette knife
Oil Paints: Yellow Ochre, Burnt Sienna, Terra Rosa, Hansa Yellow, Cadmium Red Light, Alizarin Crimson or Quinacridone Red Ultramarine Blue (Deep, if possible), Cerulean, Viridian Sap Green (Utrecht makes a permanent version)

Canvases: Canvas boards, the best quality you can afford; any of the following sizes, $8^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $10^{\prime \prime}, 9^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}, 11^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}, 12^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{\prime \prime}$.
