

## **Painting on Location in the Pecos Materials List**

Backpack with Outdoor Easel/Palette  
Panels 9" x 12", 11" x 14", 12" x 16", 14" x 18" /Carrier for wet canvases  
Brushes: interlocking, flagged, hog bristle flats or filberts #2, #4, #6, #8, #10; synthetic brush flat #8 for lay-ins (if you like)  
Palette knife and or painting knife  
Paper Towels (Viva recommended)      Nitrile Gloves  
Re-usable Trash Bag or Plastic Grocery Bags  
Sketchbook with Pencils and eraser  
Black Felt Tip Pen (Sharpie)  
Bug Spray  
Brush Cleaning Jar  
Snacks  
Water  
Camera  
Sunscreen  
Comfortable lower wear, layers  
Dark Neutral Shirt, layers  
Jacket  
Cap or Hat to deflect the sun's rays from your field of vision  
Gamsol Solvent  
Painting Medium (light) or Liquin  
Lightweight chair or stool  
Artist's Painting Umbrella-I don't recommend this as it usually causes more problems than it solves)

Yellow Ochre, Burnt Sienna, Terra Rosa
