Large sketchpad (at least 18x24) white paper, at least 70lb
Newsprint paper sketchpad (18x24)
Drawing board—at least 18x24 in size
2 bulldog clips (if drawing board has no clips)
2-3 sheets grey drawing paper – Canford 20.5 X 30.5 Gun Metal Grey
2-3 sheets black drawing paper– Canford 20.5 X 30.5 jet black
Package of vine charcoal, soft or medium, varying widths.
Package of compressed charcoal (recommend Conte Paris, soft or assorted hardness)
White charcoal
3B, 6B and 8B graphite pencils
2B, 4B and 6B charcoal pencils
White charcoal pencil
Regular eraser (pink pearl, etc.)
Kneadable eraser
Set of Chalk pastels AND/OR set of Oil pastels (the more colors the better)
Black india ink
Bamboo ink brush
Bamboo ink sketch pen
Workable spray fixative
Viewcatcher

Wooden dowel, .5" thick, at least 3' long (available at hardware stores)
