

Portfolio Building for Teens with Neecy Twinem

Materials List

1. Good set of drawing pencils. Soft to hard. (NOT mechanical)
2. Pencil sharpener
3. Detail eraser and a kneaded eraser.
4. Sketch Book, A bound sketchbook at least 8x10" or larger.
5. Drawing paper pad, 18"x24"
6. 11"x17" Pad or sheets of good all purpose paper, heavy enough to take ink and watercolors.
7. Pad of tracing paper
8. Fine tip marker/ pen. i.e., Micron (black ink)
9. Brush tip marker/ pen
10. Charcoal stick and charcoal pencil
11. Blending stump
12. Set of soft pastels, 24 colors or more is best.
13. Set of watercolors, cakes or tubes
14. Watercolor brushes, round and flat, several sizes.
15. Low tack masking tape, (blue tape)

16. Sponges, real, several sizes
17. Acrylic paint, primary colors plus black, white, brown and yellow ochre, as many colors as you want. (Liquitex Basics is fine.)
18. Paper plates for a palette
19. Variety of long handled brushes, synthetic and or bristle, round, flat etc.
20. Palette knife. (plastic is fine)
21. Paper towels and rags.
22. 2 canvas, 16"x20" and 2 11"x14", Other sizes are fine too.
23. Smock or apron if you want.
