Introduction to Children's Book Illustration with Neecey Twinem

Everyone will need:

1. Enthusiasm and creative ideas.
2. good sketch paper,(not bound in a book) at least 8"x10" or larger.
3. Drawing materials, good quality pencils and erasers
4. Drawing pen, black
5. Ruler
6. Drawing boards
7. Blue painters tape
8. Transfer paper, Saral or other brand. White if it is to be used on dark background.

As for the final medium you will work in, you have a choice. Everyone might have a medium that you like to work in but here are some choices below:

Watercolors:

140 lb. cold press paper, several sheets, Good watercolors, pan or tubes brushes, pallet to mix colors, paper towels, sponges, board for taping down paper.

Acrylic:

140 lb. cold press paper, several sheets, Acrylic Gesso, good acrylics in many colors (Liquitex Basics is fine), Acrylic brushes, paper towels, paper plates for pallet, board for taping down paper.

Soft Chalk Pastels:

Colored Pastel paper, a variety of colored pastels and pastel pencils, blending tools, board for taping down paper.

Collage or mixed media

You can use whatever you want. You can mix cut paper with a variety of papers and other materials.
